

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE
UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
AND THE
AMERICAN POSTAL WORKERS UNION, AFL-CIO**

RE: Information Technology Bargaining Unit Telework Pilot Program

The United States Postal Service and the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO (hereinafter referred to as "the parties") agree to extend the current Information Technology Bargaining Unit Telework Pilot Program for thirty (30) days.

All terms and conditions set forth in the current Telework MOU dated May 26, 2023, will remain in effect during the extension period.

The extension for the Telework MOU will expire on July 30, 2024. If an agreement on the Telework MOU cannot be reached by July 30, 2024, the parties will work together on a transition plan to return the employees to their official duty stations as soon as reasonably possible, but in no less than sixty (60) days.
